To support our graduating Indigenous students, the Canadian Dental Hygienists Association (CDHA) has partnered with HuFriedyGroup to launch the 2023 Indigenous Student Bursary. The bursary will provide financial support to Indigenous students in the final year of their dental hygiene program, graduating between September 1, 2023, and August 31, 2024.

Examples of proof include Indian status card, provincial or federal Métis citizenship card, Inuit beneficiary card, letter outlining your Indigenous ancestry, community/familial ties or kinship bonds.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all items are received by the application deadline. Incomplete applications or documents received after the deadline will not be considered.

Disbursement of Funds

All qualified applicants will receive a bursary of equal value, based on the number of HuFriedy EverEdge 204S sickle scalers with orange signature grips sold through CDHA. Recipients must submit a copy of their dental hygiene diploma or official transcript to CDHA whose staff will then forward the bursary funds via e-transfer.
