

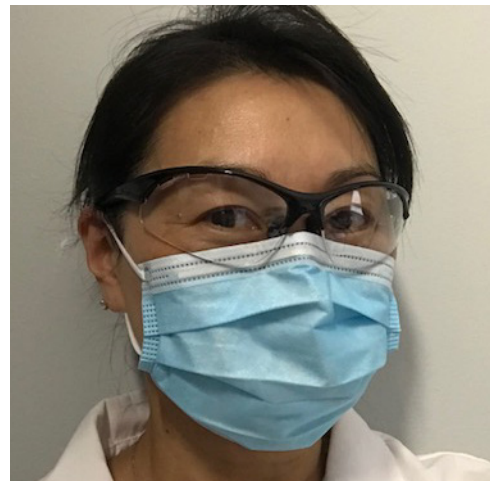
Donna Lee, RDH, MPH/DPH
