

2020 Call for Nominations CDHA Life Membership Award

The Canadian Dental Hygiene Association (CDHA) Life Membership Award is awarded annually to one individual who has made an outstanding contribution to both the profession of dental hygiene and the association at the national level. Nominators may submit only one nomination for the award. The nominee must be an active CDHA member in good standing.

Eligibility of Nominee

- Continuous CDHA membership in the active category for a minimum of twenty (20) years.
- Has made a significant contribution, over a period of at least 10 years, to the growth and achievement of the national association and shall reflect one or more of the CDHA National Competencies:

Advocacy	Collaboration
Culturally Relevant Practice	Determinants of Health
Diversity	Ethics
Leadership	Social Justice

Community Involvement Mentorship Health Promotion Social Responsibility

Supporting Documentation

- Name and contact information of the nominee
- Written support of two (2) CDHA members in good standing
- Written support must clearly reflect the eligibility criteria noted above
- A detailed curriculum vitae (CV) of the nominee.
- An outline of accomplishments at the national level that the nominators consider worthy of this award.

Nominations and supporting documents will be kept confidential and will only be used by the CDHA for the award nomination process.

Submission
