2015 Job Market & Employment Survey Highlights

- Average hourly rate increase
 - Above national rate of inflation
- Experience
 - Less than 1 year: national avg. \$35.35/hour
 - More than 20 years: national avg. \$44.01/hour
 - Rates vary by province

• 2.1% unemployment rate among respondents vs. 7.1% current Canadian unemployment rate

- List skills, experience, abilities
- Format, editing, and design

• Cover Letter

- First impression
- Customize
- Research employer
- Format, editing, and design







The Interview

- Preparation
 - Research
 - Practice

Presentation

Dress professionally, conservatively

• Job fit

- Position / firm right fit?
- Ask questions





The Interview

Communication and etiquette

- Good verbal and non-verbal communication skills
- Listen carefully, answer thoughtfully
- Arrive early



Concluding the interview

- Thank interviewer, restate interest and qualifications
- Next steps
- Thank you note
- Working interviews

Contracts

Self-employed vs. employee status

• Contract wording will determine if Revenue Canada decides you are employee vs. independent contractor

Contract <u>OF</u> service = employer-employee

Contract <u>FOR</u> services = self-employment

Control | Economic reality | Ownership | Integration



- Own/run business
- Work independently or lead a team
- Freedom to make own decisions
- Offer clients a wider range of choices
- Improve access to dental hygiene care
