Latest announcements about the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS)

Last week the government announced an extension to the CEWS by an additional 12 weeks to August 29, 2020. The government will consult with key business and labour representatives over the next month on potential adjustments to the program. The CEWS application process launched April 27.

Latest announcements about the Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA)

This week, the government announced an expansion to the eligibility criteria for the CEBA to include many owner-operated small businesses. The program will now be available to a greater number of businesses that are sole proprietors receiving income directly from their businesses.
