This article is designed to assist dental hygiene health professionals interpret and apply their obligations under the Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA) during the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

#### About the Canada Emergency Response Benefit announced yesterday

The government's new Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) will replace the previously announced Emergency Care Benefit and Emergency Support Benefit. This taxable benefit provides \$2,000 a month for up to four months for workers who lose their income as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Highlights:

 Covers Canadians who have lost their job, are sick, quarantined, or taking care of someone who is sick with COVID-19, as well as working parents who must stay home without pay to care for children who are sick or at home because of school and daycare closures.

- Applies to wage earners, as well as contract workers and self-employed individuals who would not otherwise be eligible for EI.
- The online portal for accessing the CERB will be available in early April with payments to follow in 14 days.
- Accessing the Canada Emergency Response Benefit will not have an impact on future eligibility of El claims.
- Review CDHA's Government Support FAQs or visit the government's economic response plan page for full benefit details.
