

FEDERAL PPE ONLINE SUPPLY HUB

June 2020

On June 9th the government launched the **PPE Supply Hub** which brings together resources for organizations buying and selling personal protective equipment (PPE). The Hub connects organizations from across Canada with federal, provincial, territorial and other resources about PPE, including consumer guidance. In short, it is a collection of resources about PPE (rather than a federal distribution portal of PPE).

The Hub is run by Public Services and Procurement Canada (PSPC) and indicates that it will be updated as new information and resources become available.

ACQUIRING PPE

Acquiring or purchasing PPE is done through provincial, territorial or third-party resources as listed below. Currently, the federal government is not distributing PPE for individual requests.
