Number of COVID-19 cases within the Canadian dental hygiene community

As of March 1, 2021, ADHA reported that 6.8% of American dental hygienists surveyed had contracted COVID-19 since the start of the pandemic. A total of 2,754 dental hygienists responded to CDHA's confidential poll (May 13 - 20, 2021). Results indicate that 3.45% of respondents have tested positive for COVID-19 compared to a <u>national average</u> of 4.1% as of May 20, 2021. Dental hygienists that tested positive to COVID-19 were asked to identify the source of transmission. The results are as follow:

Source of transmission (n= 97 responses)

•	Unknown	30%
•	Direct transmission from a person	51%
•	Indoor community transmission	8%
•	Outdoor community transmission	2%
•	Workplace transmission	9%

Poll results suggest that the pandemic measures put in place including public health measures, COVID-19 infection prevention and control guidelines and COVID-19 vaccination are effective.
