

Right to Refuse Unsafe Work Conditions

Know your worker rights and responsibilities and the steps you can take to remediate unsafe work conditions or exercise your right to refuse unsafe work. Procedures may vary by province, please see your provincial site below.

Before you report unsafe work practices, you can:

- discuss your concerns with your professional regulator
- discuss your concerns with your supervisor or employer
- consult your joint health and safety committee member or health and safety representative, if there is one
